

My dear teacher, I dedicate this poem to you,



Signs and Labels



'Peace begins with a smile.' Mother Teresa









Students also learned about a few facts on Mother Teresa's life. The activities concluded with a beautiful 'Kindness Bucket' sharing their ideas in ways to help the society.
